Things that were discussed at the meeting were dates for the following;

**Range spring cleanup April 20<sup>th</sup>** starting at 9:00AM until we are done. Please plan on helping. We will be sending out an e-mail reminder just before hand as a reminder.

**Hunters Sight in** will be held on **October 5-6<sup>th</sup>**, and again on **October 19-20<sup>th</sup>**. Times will be 9:00AM to 4:00PM each day. Again make plans to help if you can.

**Club Membership Orientation grace period is ending in July.** All members who have not taken an orientation will be required to take one even if you have been a member for the last two years. When the club began requiring all new members to take an orientation existing members were given a grace period of two years attend an orientation. This grace period is ending on July 1 2013. If you join between now and July you will get a key without taking the orientation, but in 1014 you will not receive a key until you do. Anyone joining after July 1 2013 will be required to take an orientation class before getting a key.

Range orientations are held every month on the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30pm before the regular meetings (March, May, July, Sept, Nov, & Jan). On the months we don't have meetings the orientations are at 7:00pm. All meetings/orientations are at the Flathead County Fairgrounds 4H building, in Kalispell.

I am mentioning this as we would like to get more members in the club. We are planning on advertising in the Mountain Trader for the next few months to see what kind of response we get.
